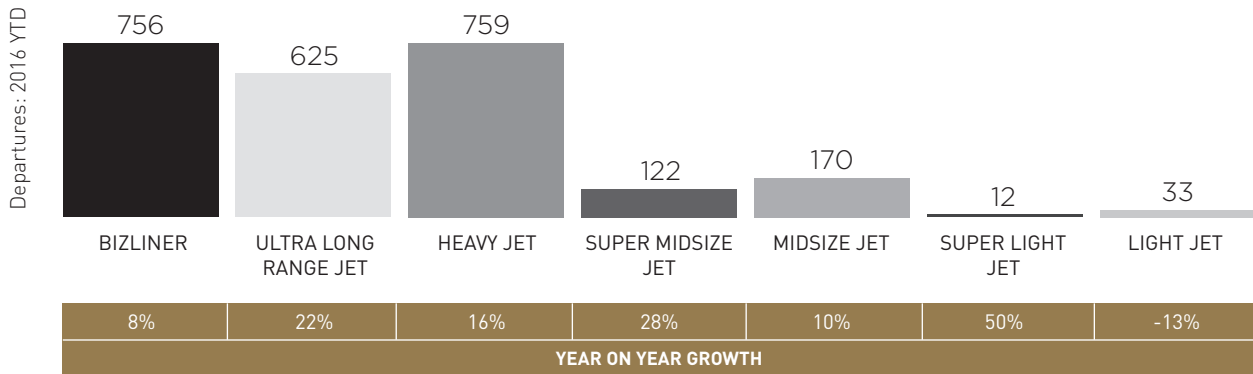


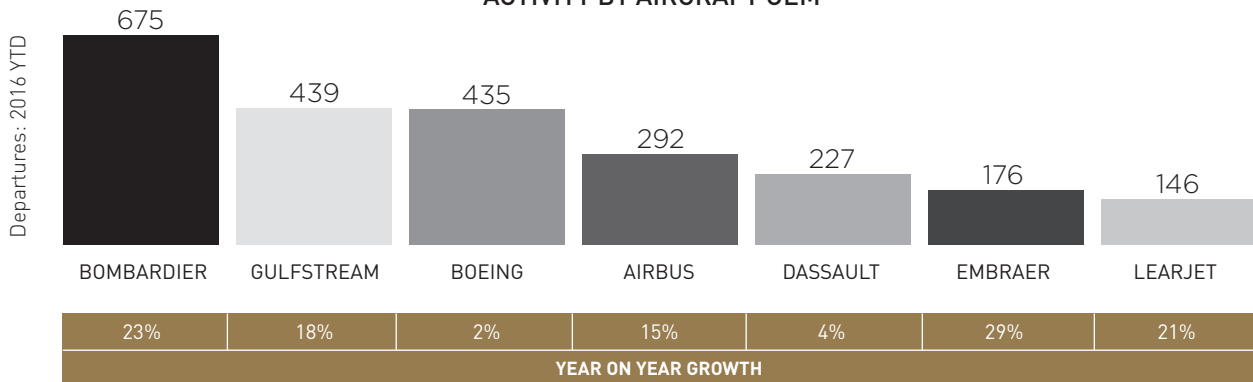

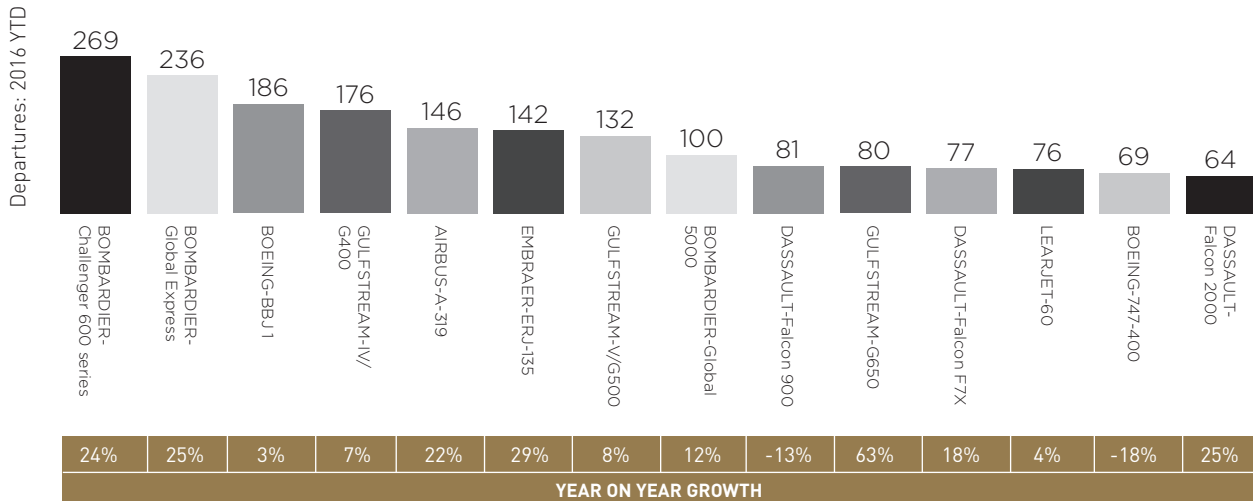
#### ACTIVITY BY AIRCRAFT SEGMENT



#### ACTIVITY BY AIRCRAFT OEM



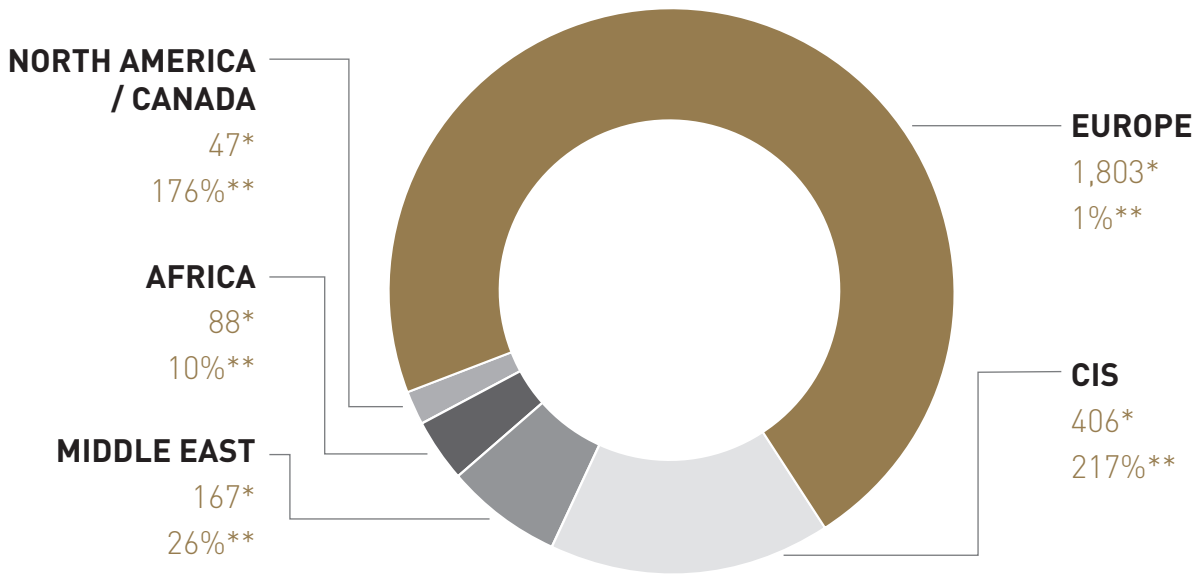
#### ACTIVITY BY AIRCRAFT TYPE (TOP 15)

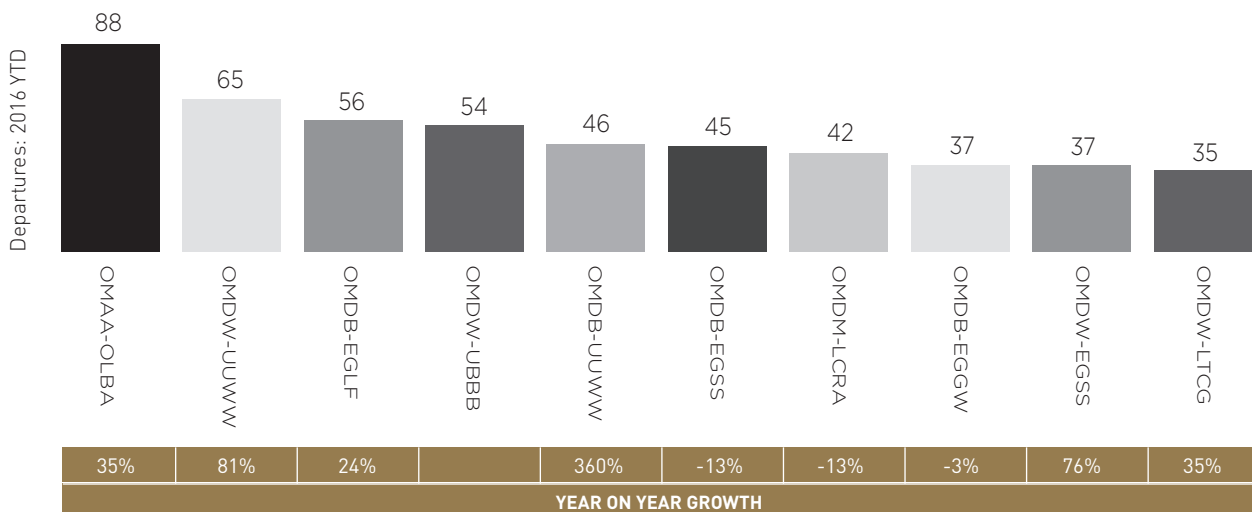
